God has revealed much about angels in the pages of the Holy Bible signaling their prominence in creation and their importance for our lives. We shouldn't miss out on the help of these spirits just because we cannot see them. Nor should we allow ourselves to fall into mistaken beliefs about angels when the truth has been revealed to us in Scripture. In the course of this study, we'll examine biblical passages to discern what God has revealed to us about angels. Additionally, we will explore Pope Blessed John Paul II's 1986 catechetical series on the angels, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, and the writings of early Church fathers, especially St. Augustine of Hippo. Each week, we will start with a review of the study guide questions, written by Mike Aquilina, followed by a video lecture featuring Fr. Mitch Pacwa.

Every year on the first Sunday of Lent, the Gospel reading is about Jesus going off to the wilderness, or desert, for forty days. On Ash Wednesday, we begin our own forty days in the desert. This penitential season of Lent is an intense time of spiritual renewal. The Church especially invites us to pray, fast and give alms as means of expressing our utter dependence on God who through the waters of Baptism shares His very life with us. This six week study based on the Sunday readings during Lent features a study guide written by Mark Shea and video lectures featuring Fr. Mitch Pacwa.
